## PDG Interoperability Committee – Review of Trace WG model v2.0.0 Differences between Tracing Model v1.1.0 and v2.0.0

## Trace Request Model - v2.0.0 Changes

- 1. The "TI Request Investigation ID" (optional) was added as a reference for potential future communications.
- 2. Investigation Reason Attestation: added choices "Compliance Audit" and "Health Authority Inspection"
- 3. "On Behalf of Authority" (optional) was added. If chosen, the Authority's contact information is **required** so that the Responder can contact the Authority directly to discuss and respond. The original Requester should not expect a Response.
- 4. Multiple 3911 Incident Numbers (optional) are now allowed.
- 5. "Additional Information" (optional) was added to include documents or photos.

## Trace Response Model - v2.0.0 Changes

- 1. "TI Requester Investigation ID" (optional) was added to reference the "Investigation ID" (optional) that may have been included in the Request.
- 2. v1.1.0 included *temporary* message codes "xx1, xx2, etc.". Assigned unique codes for issues with the entire Request (RM-001, RM-002, etc.) and individual request line numbers (RL-001, RL-002, etc.).
- 3. "Additional Information" (optional) was added to include documents or photos.
- 4. Multiple 3911 Incident Numbers (optional) are now allowed.
- 5. "Owner Information Notes" (optional) was added to Ownership Information Responses. Responders can add context to the Ownership Information, such as whether the product has been returned and resold.
- 6. "Transaction Information Notes" (optional) were added to the Transaction Information Response Data. This allows Respondents to add context to the Transaction Information, such as whether the product has been returned and resold.
